The German Skiverband e.V. (“DSV”) in conjunction with the [Stadtverwaltung Titisee-Neustadt, World Cup Office, Pfauenstraße 2, 79822 Titisee-Neustadt](#) has adopted extensive concepts and measures in order to make professional winter sporting events (World Cup and World Championships) in Germany possible despite the current SARS-CoV-2 pandemic. In the past 14 days I have not knowingly had contact with a Covid-19 infected person, suspected infected person or someone who has had direct contact with an infected person. You also confirm you are aware of and take seriously the fact that despite extensive protective measures, there remains some risk of becoming infected with the SARS-CoV-2 corona virus in conjunction with event participation. It is requested that all participants personally weigh their personal risk of infection and determine if taking part in the event is in his/her best interest (especially for those individuals identified by the Robert Koch Institute as being high risk).

DATA PROTECTION INFORMATION ACCORDING TO ART. 13 DSGVO

As the person responsible within the meaning of the European General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") and the Federal Data Protection Act ("BDSG"), the [Titisee-Neustadt City Administration, World Cup Office, Pfauenstrasse 2, 79822 Titisee-Neustadt](#) (hereinafter: "Organizer") collects, processes and uses) in order to ensure that the event specified in the questionnaire is carried out safely for all parties, taking into account the data protection regulations applicable in the Federal Republic of Germany, in particular the GDPR and the BDSG, personal data in connection with the answer to the questionnaire by the signatory and the admission control to the event site on Day of the event.

This data protection information explains which data of the signatory is recorded in the course of answering the questionnaire and checking it as well as the admission control to the event site on the day of the event and how this data is processed. The signatory will be informed separately about other processing of his data, e.g. in connection with the booking or accreditation for the event, by the company responsible for this.

1. Which personal data are collected?

As part of the questionnaire, the following data of the signatory is collected and processed: first and last name, company, contact details (e-mail, telephone number), details about the event (venue, competition) and answers to the questions in the questionnaire as well as the time of the Admission control and test results (PCR) carried out.

2. On what legal basis and for what purposes these data are processed?

- The personal data of the signatory will only be processed if a legal basis from the GDPR, the BDSG or another applicable data protection norm allows this. The processing is based in particular on the following legal bases:
- Insofar as the processing takes place to fulfill a legal obligation to which the person responsible is subject, Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 c) GDPR, and, insofar as the processing includes health-related data, in conjunction with Art. 9 para. 2 i) GDPR in conjunction with the currently valid version of the Corona Ordinance of the State of Baden Württemberg (CoronaVO BaWü) and
- as far as the processing is necessary to protect legitimate interests and the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the signatory do not prevail, Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 f) GDPR, and, as far as the

processing includes health-related data, Art. 9 Para 2 f) and i), Section 22 Paragraph 1 No. 1 c) BDSG, and

- as far the processing takes place on the basis of the consent of the person concerned, Art. 9 para. 2 a) GDPR.

2.1 Fulfillment of legal obligations, Art. 6 Paragraph 1 Clause 1 c) GDPR, Art. 9 Paragraph 2 i) GDPR

Insofar as the organizer is legally obliged to do so, it will inform the responsible health office in the event of suspected infection or a proven infection of the signatory or a contact person of the signatory with the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus in order to support it in tracking and containing possible sources of infection and others To discuss measures. This data transfer is justified in accordance with Art. 6 Paragraph 1 Clause 1 c) GDPR, Art. 9 Paragraph 2 i) GDPR in conjunction with the currently valid version of the CoronaVO BaWü.

2.2 Preservation of legitimate interests, Art. 6 Paragraph 1 Sentence 1 f) GDPR, Art. 9 Paragraph 2 f) and i) GDPR, Section 22 Paragraph 1 No. 1 c) BDSG

To ensure the health and safety of all people present on the event site at the event (including athletes and support teams, referees, people involved in the implementation of the event and the associated TV production and media coverage), their relatives and their personal environment and for reasons In the public interest to protect against serious cross-border health threats, the organizer processes the information from the questionnaire in accordance with Art. 6 Paragraph 1 Sentence 1 f) GDPR, Art. 9 Paragraph 2 i) GDPR, Section 22 Paragraph 1 No. 1 c) BDSG. The measures for running the event were coordinated with the responsible authorities (e.g. local health department). The organizer will keep the completed and signed questionnaire until any claims that the undersigned could assert due to the use of their personal data have expired. The storage is to safeguard the legitimate interest of those responsible in the ability to prove the proper implementation of the admission control and comprehensive data protection information for the signatory in accordance with Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 f) GDPR and to assert, exercise and defend possible legal claims in accordance with Art. 9 Paragraph 2 f) GDPR justified

2.3 Consent, Art. 9 Para. 2 a) GDPR

To ensure the health and safety of all persons present on the event site at the event, a negative PCR test result is required, which is only possible with the prior consent of the person concerned, Art. 9 Para. 2 a) GDPR.

3. Who will the data of the signatory be transmitted to?

3.1 The completed questionnaire will be sent by the undersigned to the organizer, who will keep it with her.

3.2 If the signatory is suspected of being infected or if such an infection with the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus is even proven, the organizer, insofar as it is legally obliged to do so, will get in touch with the contact persons of the signatory concerned in order to locate and contain sources of infection put in touch. It will of course endeavor not to disclose the identity of the signatory concerned to these contact persons and only inform them about groups or areas without specific names. If, in exceptional cases, this is not sufficient (e.g. due to very close contact with the signatory concerned), disclosure of the identity of the signatory concerned may nevertheless be necessary. If necessary, during this, information about the signatory is also transmitted to the responsible health department.

3.3 Otherwise, personal data of the signatory will only be passed on if legal provisions allow or require this.

4. How long will personal data of the signatory be stored?

All data will be deleted when they are no longer required for the purposes for which they were collected. As a rule, the personal data collected by means of the questionnaire will be deleted no later than four weeks after it has been collected, unless the signatory has consented to longer storage or the organizer is entitled or obliged to store longer due to legal regulations.

5. Signatory's Rights

5.1 Rights of the signatory: According to the GDPR, the signatory has a number of rights, in particular a right to information about the personal data stored about him (Art. 15 GDPR), correction of incorrect data (Art. 16 GDPR), deletion of the data (under the conditions 17 GDPR), restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR), data portability according to Art. 20 GDPR; and objection to processing, insofar as this is done to safeguard legitimate interests (Art. 21 GDPR). In addition, there is a right of appeal to the responsible data protection supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR).
